

WARNING!

- Do not drill into the gas tank.** Check on and behind the mounting surface to ensure there are no wires, cables, gas and hydraulic lines or other items that may be damaged by the mounting screws.

- Check that StorAKey is securely mounted.** Mounting StorAKey in a secure fashion for all driving conditions is the installer's responsibility.

- Check that the StorAkey will not interfere with the range of motion of moving parts such as tires, shock absorbers, axles and tire chains.**

- Check that the StorAkey does not hang down where it can drag on speed bumps or interfere with car jacks.**

- Check that there is room for your StorAKey cover to open.**

¡ADVERTENCIA!



- Verifique que el StorAkey no cuegue de una pieza donde pueda ser arrastrado al pasar los topes de control de velocidad o interferir con el uso del gato.**

- Verifique que haya suficiente espacio para abrir la cubierta del StorAkey.**


can be used as a template to mark the hole locations on the mounting surface. Insert the vault into the base of the cover. Use the four self-drilling and tapping screws provided to attach your StorAkey to a metal surface.

b. Mounting Plate Option.

If you are mounting your StorAkey onto a metal rod or loop such as a tow hook, insert the vault into the base of the cover. Place the vault (with cover) on side of the metal rod facing you and the mounting plate on the other side of the metal rod. Using the four screws provided, screw from the holes in the back of the vault through the cover and into the pre-drilled holes of the mounting plate on the other side until vault is braced tight against metal rod so it does not move. Remove the vault and mounting plate if you find it necessary to use the tow hook for towing you vehicle.




- See the enclosed Pushbutton Instructions to set your personal StorAkey combination and to operate your keybox.
- When placing the lid on the vault, make sure it is fully locked into place.
- To close the rubber cover, rotate the cover closed and latch the strap over the catch. Make sure that the tabs on the rubber cover are in the channels on the base.
- To open the rubber cover, pull the strap away from the cover and rotate the cover open.
- Periodically check that the vault, inside of rubber cover and drain holes are clean and free of grit to ensure proper operation of the rubber cover.



Read and understand all instructions before mounting your StorAKey.

1. Find Location. Find a flat location

where you want to mount your StorAKey. Common mounting locations include the frame, sheet metal of the undercarriage, tow hook, trailer hitch, bumpers, wheel well, fender brace, truck toolbox, spare tire carrier and unlocked RV compartments.

2. Prepare StorAKey for Mounting.








Remove the lid from the keybox by pushing down on the OPEN button.

3. Determine Mounting Option

- a. **Direct Mount Option.** If you are mounting your StorAKey onto a thick surface such as a frame member, you may want to drill 0.44-inch diameter pilot holes for mounting screws before attaching your StorAKey. The cover




Direct Mount

- Asegúrese de leer y comprender todas las instrucciones antes de montar el StorAKey.**
1. **Encuentre el lugar apropiado.** Encuentre un lugar plano donde desea montar su StorAKey. Los lugares más comunes incluyen el chasis del vehículo, la carrocería abajo, el enganche para la grúa, el enganche del remolque, los parachoques, la cavidad de la rueda, la caja de herramientas, el portador de la llanta de repuesto, y los compartimientos accesibles de los vehículos recreativos (RV).
2. **Prepare el StorAKey para montarlo.** Remueve la tapa de la cajita fuerte metálica de llaves prestando el botón "OPEN" (abrir).
3. **Determine Cuál Opción Desea Usar para Montarlo.**

- a. **Opción de Montaje Directo.** Si está montando el StorAKey sobre una superficie gruesa tal como una parte del chasis del vehículo, quizás querrá taladrar huecos del diámetro de 0.44 de una pulgada para los tornillos de montaje, antes de fijar el StorAKey. Puede usar la misma "cajita fuerte" de metal del StorAKey como una plantilla o patrón para marcar los lugares
